# XXIII Conference, "Resilience, Innovation and Behaviour Change in Transport" Roma, September 30<sup>th</sup> – October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

### **Call for papers**

We are pleased to announce that the **XXIII Conference of the Italian Society of Transport Economics** and Logistics (SIET) (<u>www.sietitalia.org</u>) will be on the **30<sup>th</sup> September and 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021.** The conference is organised by TRElab (Transport Research Laboratory, <u>www.trelab.it</u>), Roma Tre University. Given the current situation with COVID19, we foresee the conference to take place online. However, should the situation improve in the next months, we will consider organising it in presence. The title of this year Conference is "**Resilience, Innovation and Behaviour Change in Transport**".

The aim of the Conference is to promote the academic debate and in-depth scientific interactions among researchers and experts on recent advances in the field of transport economics with a specific focus on resilience, innovation and behaviour change. Keynote lectures by international experts of the field will be organised.

Theoretical and empirical papers are welcome on the topic of the Conference and on related issues. In particular, papers are welcome when dealing with topics pertaining to the critical pillars of the recently published European Commission's document titled "Sustainable and smart mobility strategy" which can be downloaded <u>here</u>. More in detail, we welcome papers dealing with the Flagships reported below:

- Flagship 1 boosting the uptake of zero-emission vehicles, renewable & low-carbon fuels and related infrastructure
- Flagship 2 creating zero-emission airports and ports
- Flagship 3 making interurban and urban mobility more sustainable and healthy
- Flagship 4 greening freight transport
- Flagship 5 pricing carbon and providing better incentives for users
- Flagship 6 making connected and automated multimodal mobility a reality
- Flagship 7 innovation, data and artificial intelligence for smarter mobility
- Flagship 8 reinforcing the single market
- Flagship 9 making mobility fair and just for all
- Flagship 10 enhancing transport safety and security

We also welcome proposals for dedicated sessions on specific issues. The proponent should send an abstract for the thematic session and a list of possible contributions and authors.

A special session will be organised in **memory of Prof. Giancarlo Polidori** who passed away in 2020. Further details will soon be circulated.



Awards





SIET announces the "Annual SIET Prize for young transport economist" (< 30 years). The prize, at the third edition, amounts to € 350,00 plus a three-year waiver of the subscription fees to SIET (per winner).

SIET also announces the "Giancarlo Polidori Best Paper Award" to a graduate student or a PhD candidate. The prize amounts to € 500,00, granted by TRElab, Roma Tre University. Submitted papers, whether theoretical or empirical, can pertain to any subject in the area of transport economics and logistics with a particular emphasis on transport policy and behaviour change.

Researchers that would like to participate to any of the two awards need to indicate which one of them they choose when submitting the abstract/paper. While one candidate can submit a paper for both prizes, it can only win one of them.

#### Abstract submission

Please submit an extended **abstract** (2-4 pages or approximately 1000 words) at the following link: <u>www.trelab.it/siet2021</u>. The abstract should clearly state the research question, the methodology, the main (or expected) results and references. The document should indicate title, author(s), affiliations, corresponding contact, three keywords.

Contributors will have to submit a **full paper**, should the abstract be accepted, before the Conference following specific instructions that will be made available later on.

- Extended Abstract submission deadline: April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- Accepted abstracts notification: **May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021**
- Full paper submission deadline: August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021
