







"Giancarlo Polidori Best Paper Award"

TRElab, together with the Urbino University, is pleased to announce the ""Giancarlo Polidori Best Paper Award" for the best paper submitted by a young graduate or a PhD candidate.

Submitted papers, whether theoretical or empirical, can pertain to any subject in the area of transport economics and logistics with a particular emphasis on transport policy and behavioural change.

The prize money is € 500,00, granted by TRElab, Roma Tre University.

It is intended for an outstanding unpublished paper, written by one or more authors who are young graduates or Ph.D. candidates.

The full paper to be evaluated must be submitted within August 31st, 2021.

To compete for the prize, it is necessary to submit an abstract to the XXIII SIET Scientific Meeting; during the submission, when asked about her/his participation in the competition for the "Giancarlo Polidori Best Paper award", the candidate must answer "yes".

The paper must be presented at the XXIII Scientific Meeting of the Italian Society of Transport Economics and Logistics (SIET) that will take place online on September 30th-October 1st, 2021.

A paper could be jointly written, but

- 1. the candidate, regularly registered to the Conference, must present it;
- 2. all co-authors must be young graduates and/or PhD candidates and/or non-tenured.

The author(s) can submit more than one paper.

The Paper Awards Committee is responsible for the winner(s)'s selection and bestows it based on a synthetic evaluation report.

The prize will be awarded during the Scientific Meeting.
